October



KEY LEARNINGS FROM THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR

- Lessons learned on organization for both Snack Shack & FUN Lunches. With each event we received valuable feedback and have adjusted so these activities are not as disruptive to the learning environment as they were in the beginning
- Progress made on recruiting volunteers, will continue to advocate and make volunteer opportunities accessible and easy to sign up for
- Will ensure events are calendared and planned further in advance

KEY SUCCESSES FROM THE 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR

- Purchase of the school branded awning for sports and other events
- Contribution to speaker/presenter Mackenzie Brown attending the school for an assembly
- Earmarked a fund to be utilized for families unable to afford field trip costs or similar (to work with Admin for the use of this fund)
- Increase volunteerism
- Created a strong social media presence
- Created Fundraising Society and working towards having the society participate in Casino fundraising activities
- Continued to foster the feeling of community as our new school settles in, being a visible presence in the school
- Enjoyed the information shared by the teachers and admin during SC meetings
