- a) Introductions made, including a moment to recognize and bring attention to the fantastic commitment and hard work given by the grade 8 class this year and the classroom success they have earned from it
- b) Science learning about water systems, mix and flow of matter, light and optics, mechanical systems (which is the present class topic) and final section coming up cells and systems
- c) Social Studies world views, world history, focus studies on places like Japan and its island isolation aspect, The Renaissance period of European culture, Aztec and Spanish study of opposing worldview leading to conflict
