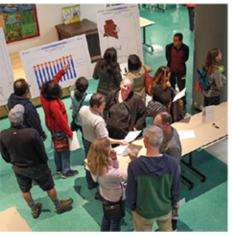

How is Our School Development Plan Used?

- Guides ongoing assessment and review of goals and actions.
- Our school development plan is the driver for closing learning gaps and informs:
 - Instructional strategies
 - Professional learning
 - School structures and processes for learning
 - Resources to improve student learning
 - Data-informed decision making





School Development Plan – Overall Goal

 Prairie Sky School will focus on assessment practices across all disciplines. The use of common leveled assessments in each grade will allow for calibration and better understanding of our learners.

School Development Plan – Literacy Improvement



We will continue to use local measure data (CC3, LeNS, and numeracy) along with the Words Their Way assessment and report card data (reading and number) to guide our work in decoding and encoding. Division 2 & 3 will be using the CBE Decision Tree specifically the CORE Maze, CORE Vocab, & Words Their Way. We have chosen to continue our work in these areas despite significant progress last year in order to cement quality instruction practices and build consistency across all grade levels. Grades 1-9, LP 1, 2, and 3 students: Linguistic Vocabulary indicators for Reading on the CBE ESL Proficiency Benchmarks Tracking online tool in PowerTeacher Portal

School Development Plan – Mathematics Improvement

In Mathematics, we are focusing on common grade level assessments to guide our work. These assessments have two main purposes. First, is to promote consistency and give teachers the opportunity to practice layering Math framework rubrics over their assessments. Second, to provide a diagnostic assessment to measure improvement throughout the year. We plan to gradually increase the number of common assessments in subsequent years to promote quality assessment and greater understanding of our students' math skills.







School Development Plan – Well-Being Improvement

• In Well-Being we will use the results from the OurSCHOOL Survey, the CBE Student Survey and the Assurance Survey. Using the MindUp program we will build common language across the school focusing on key vocabulary words and concepts. Using our learner profiles students will respond to the following questions: Who does this student feel most connected to in school? What makes them feel like they belong? What makes them feel seen or heard?
