- This month we hear from the Grade 2 teachers
- -Grade 2 Learning Highlights
- a) In line with the School Development Plan, Grade 2 teachers are actively incorporating all the key elements into their classrooms
- b) Literacy UFLI Foundations, activities centered around decoding, phenomics awareness and irregular words, building skills in these techniques to improve student reading / writing skills
- c) Finding consistent opportunities to practice literacy skills, tasks like A Sentence A Day and meaning exploration exercises where students examine a words meaning by writing about it, building their vocabulary through expanding their understanding of a words use and place in sentence structure
- d) Exploring definitions, writing about what a word means to expand understanding and apply literacy skills
- e) Poetry writing, using the theme of seasons changing as we move from winter to spring
- f) Mathematics Grade 2 introduces a big jump into larger double-digit numbers, approaching these new numbers by enhancing skills introduced in Grade 1 such as number lines
- g) Science Exciting physics learning through practical examples of motion, force, light and temperature
- h) Computers / Robotics Using teaching tools like Osobot to engage students in experiments, predicting outcomes and observing the results
- i) Students had opportunity recently to participate in Teachers Pet program, a exciting day filled with hands on science experiments and learning that allowed students to experience different applications and approaches to science learning
- j) Social Studies Lessons of physical geography, map reading, identifying provinces and territories and exploring unique features of regions
- k) Community questions, a exercise of asking students what questions they have and things they want to know about various communities and showing them the tools and skills used in finding and recording that information
- l) Examining cultures and traditions, a engaging activity of writing reviews as if students experienced it personally, combing multiple aspects of SDP into one task to further their learning

- a) Student Led conferences upcoming, the concept of Student Led allows students to take the lead and express their school experience and give parents a glimpse of what their school days are like
