- This meeting we hear from a group of teachers at PSS called Learning Leaders
- -Learning Leaders hightlights include
- a) Members of Learning Leaders take turns introducing themselves and giving descriptions of their skillsets and areas of focus
- b) Learning Leaders are planning to bring in a Indigenous speaker to hold sessions with students including drumming and discussion with the goal of enriching student's experience at PSS, a request is made if PSSC can assist with any portion of the \$1000 needed to bring in this speaker.
- c) Physical Education teacher Jasmine Kennedy leads discussion of how the Alberta Education Health Curriculum is being presented to students, this includes areas of Sexual Education and again strictly follows established curriculum from Alberta Education in partnership with Alberta Health Services.
- d) Grade 4 is the initial entry point for this learning to begin as this age is a active stage in child development so it is vital they understand these body changes, however parents do have options to opt out their child if they wish
- e) Learning Leaders also touch on Mathematics Education, currently doing data collection via math assessments to be reviewed and applied to future lessons.

- a) Parent Teacher conferences are scheduled to take place over Nov 23 24
 - b) Halloween is coming up, Mona puts it to open discussion if we should allow students to wear their costumes to school that day, after a brief exchange it is settled that it will be allowed
 - c) School Development Plan continued focus on Literacy, Mathematics and Wellbeing, educators are approaching the upcoming conferences though a lese of assessment as they prepare to meet with parents and share updates on their progress in the SDP areas
