- Fantastic presentations of classroom activities presented by teachers from Kindergarten and Grade 5
- -Visual posters around classroom to repeat and encourage learning intentions
- Amazing support staff assisting with quiet times/ slow down moments, supporting students emotional needs
- -Kindergarten learning highlights include
- a) English Language Arts, letter recognition and writing, utilizing proven programs such as Lively Letters and Haggerty, visual journals to record and express learning progress.
- b) Math, number recognition and writing, shape identification and pattern awareness.
- c) Science, observing season changes and weather patterns, primary colors and color mixing.
- d) Social Studies, emphasis on individual uniqueness, choosing stories to share with class that explore self-identity and responsibility ex. "I Promise" by Lebron James.
